CASE STUDY

INFRASTRUCTURE ENHANCEMENT

For communities, feasible and effective infrastructure, such as roads and highways, are essential for the growth of the local economy (through trade and enhanced e-commerce) as well as the ongoing safety of residents and visitors. Sustainable public-private partnerships can ensure for adequate infrastructure project investment as well as execution, resulting in ongoing benefits for all stakeholders.

SITUATION:

Road demarcations (falling within the district of the eMalahleni Municipality in the Mpumalanga Province) had become dilapidated and were no longer visible to motorists, commuters and pedestrians; posing a significant safety hazard and potentially negatively affecting the distribution of goods.

ACTION:

Lurco met with the eMalahleni Municipality and donated 172 x 25 litre cans, valued at R200 000, towards a road refurbishment programme (part of the municipality "Quick Fix Priority Projects") - enhancing road markings and the general state of the roads in the area.

RESULT:

Paint was handed over to the Executive Mayor, Linah Malatji; members of the Mayoral Committee; and Traffic Department Chief, CJ Mnisi and the project has since been successfully completed.
